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| 16.04A | <p><u>PCSO KING:</u></p> <p>PCSO King was unable to attend the meeting, but had sent a report in which was read out for the period 22 March 2016 to 19th April 2016</p> <p>There was 1 crime:</p> <p>1 x Assault without Injury.</p>   |
| 16.04B | <p><u>PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:</u></p> <p>2 residents of Worstead attended the meeting to report a few issues to the PC:</p> <p>1 - Questioned who is responsible for the pathway under the railway bridge, as they are covered in mud, grass and weeds, leaving little pathway which is becoming dangerous for those using them. Clerk to report to Highway and to support with photographs.</p> <p>2 - Pot holes within the village. The pothole at the crossroads has already been reported to Highways, but will be followed up by the Clerk. It was mentioned that anyone can report a pothole to highways via their 'Highway Rangers' website.</p> <p>3 – Speeding in the village. The speed limit is set at 20mph, but unfortunately is not adhered too. Clerk to contact PCSO to see if he can come and monitor this, especially near the school. Can the village carry out a community speed watch? Clerk to follow up speed signs at the school for timings. Suggested by Cllr. Cole that the more complaints sent to the police should prioritise it.</p> <p>4 – The number of large lorries driving through the village is increasing. The blue signs are only advisory. Unfortunately, sat nav's can direct lorries though here. Clerk to write to local companies to ask them to ask their lorry drivers not to drive through the village.</p> <p>4 - Can a village litter pick be done? This is on the agenda to discuss.</p> <p>5 – The new play equipment is lovely.</p> <p>Handyman reported the same issue as already mentioned – pot holes, speeding, floods, all of which are being looked into.</p> <p>Play equipment – monitoring on the swings as something has abraised/cracked/split at the top on both sets of swings. Zip wire tension could do with being tightened.</p> <p>Cllr. Barrett to check reports of sharp areas on witches hat.</p> <p>The play group have given permission to use the wire fencing left over to block the hole at the corner of the playing field. To be looked at.</p> |
